
VOICES OF REASON, MINDS OF KNOWLEDGE : CLUSTER DEBATE AND QUIZ COMPETITION



Army Public School No. 1, Roorkee successfully hosted a three-day Cluster-Level English and Hindi Debate and Quiz Competition from 9 to 11 July 2025, inaugurated by Brigadier K.P. Singh, Chairman APS Roorkee, who emphasized the value of such events in nurturing confident and informed individuals. Students from nine Army Public Schools participated, showcasing their talent and knowledge across three events. APS S.P. Marg, Lucknow excelled by securing first positions in both the English Debate and Quiz, while APS Clement Town and APS Meerut took second positions respectively. APS Gorakhpur won the Hindi Debate, followed by APS Ranikhet as runner-up. The event concluded with a valedictory ceremony lauding the participants and applauding APS Roorkee's excellent coordination and hospitality, marking the event as a celebration of learning, expression, and inter-school camaraderie.

EY STEM APP LIGHTS THE WAY FOR GIRLS

On 11 July 2025, a dynamic and interactive webinar on the EY STEM App was organized by the EY Foundation for girl students of Classes IX to XII. Aimed at igniting interest in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) careers, the session provided students with hands-on experience of the app's key features such as Career Explorer, Learning Hub, and Mentor Connect. Students were guided through the registration process via a live demonstration and engaged actively during the Q&A session, resolving their doubts and exploring the app's full potential. The workshop proved to be a meaningful step towards digital empowerment and bridging the gender gap in STEM.



RETHINK SWEET



The Sugar Awareness Campaign, held from 4 to 10 July 2025 on the theme “Too much sugar? Let’s Talk!”, aimed to educate students about the harmful effects of excessive sugar consumption and promote healthier dietary habits through interactive and age-appropriate activities. Over the course of the week, activities such as awareness video screenings, an online quiz, poster-making, street plays (Nukkad Natak), a student-led panel discussion, and a live talk were conducted, engaging students from Classes VI to XII. These initiatives not only fostered health literacy but also encouraged creative expression, critical thinking, and life skills like decision-making and communication. With active participation from over 500 students, 45 teachers, and 50 parents, the campaign proved to be a meaningful and enriching experience that empowered students to make informed food choices and raise awareness within their communities.

INTER SCHOOL -KALAKRITI CONCLAVE



CHECK, CARE AND CURE



Under the “Anaemia Mukh Bharat” campaign, a hemoglobin test drive was conducted from 20 to 30 August 2025 for students of classes VI to XII, in collaboration with Military Hospital, Meerut and SHO (L) Meerut. Trained nurses from MH Meerut carried out the tests, covering a total of 2539 students. The students were individually tested and guided about healthy hemoglobin levels. Those found with low Hb levels were advised on proper dietary interventions and records were maintained for follow-up. The initiative proved successful in promoting health awareness and ensuring timely detection of anaemia among students.

BEYOND BOOKS: CAREERS OF TOMORROW

A Career Guidance Workshop on “New Age Careers” was held on 27 August 2025 for Class XII students, conducted by Ms. Tanvi Dhingra, a certified career coach from GUS Global Services. 
